

Job Title: Maintenance Work Study

Position Overview:

Working under the direction and in conjunction with a Maintenance employee for the area specified during a daily shift.

Key Responsibilities:

Aiding maintenance personnel in general, nontechnical repairs including patching, painting, cutting, gluing, lighting, lifting, holding, carrying, use of ladders, scraping/cleaning parts, plumbing, troubleshooting, accompanying in dorms, and use of basic tools. Other light duties as assigned.

- Ability to work effectively both independently and collaboratively within a team
- Dependable and punctual

Work Schedule:

This position requires a commitment of up to 15 hours per week, with a flexible schedule based on the student's availability and the needs of maintenance staff.

Compensation:

Hourly wage in accordance with Otero College's student employment program.
